This month, we will give you a tour of what our lives look like in a typical week. Please pray for us!

SATURDAY

9:00am to 10:00am English Fun Club 10:00am to 4:00pm Café at Church

Mark arrives at the church at 8:20am to set up snacks and drinks for the **English Fun Club** which starts at 9am. A few Elementary school children come to run around, shout out English phrases, play games and hear a bible story in our new meeting room. Their parents drink coffee in the next room. Peter (our colleague) has a good conversation with them and talks to them about Christian baptism as he shows them round the building. **Please pray** that the parents and the children will respond to the gospel.

Grace bakes at church for the café where a number of our regular guests come. One lady studies the bible in German with Renate (Peter's wife) and a young Christian new to our church meets with Mark to talk about how to do regular prayer and bible study. Two ladies come to practice their English and another regular sits down to talk about differences in culture between the UK and Japan. A young Christian meets with Mark to talk about how to study the bible for himself. A young non-Christian man attending a local college comes to play table tennis and spends half an hour reading a book about the gospel with one of the missionaries. Grace meets up with her friends. Towards the end of café the monthly Mum's parenting class starts which a few non-Christian Mums attend.

Please pray for encouraging fellowship and bible studies with Christians at cafe time.

Please pray that our student friend reading about the gospel will come to believe in Jesus.

Please pray for the parenting class and three young mums who are doing bible studies at our church – that they will see their need for a saviour.

SUNDAY

We arrive at church at 9:45am and Isaac (12) sits in at our new sound booth to learn how to operate it. We chat to church regulars including the husband of a member who isn't a Christian but has recently started coming regularly.

Our service is all in Japanese but we provide English notes for the sermon. Around twenty people come to the service, mostly Christians but there are a few interested non-Christians. Mark preaches on James chapter two. After the service, he meets with Grace (14) and another Junior High School girl for ten minutes to discuss how we can apply the sermon to ourselves.

Like many churches in Japan, we eat together after the service in the worship room. We are currently encouraging members to sign up to meet with us as a couple on a Sunday afternoon to ask them about their faith, how we can encourage them and how we can pray for them.

We leave church at about 2pm after cleaning the building with the help of church regulars and rest for the rest of the day.

Please pray for church regulars to be keen to meet with us pastorally.

Please pray for Christians and non-Christians to be encouraged and challenged on a Sunday morning.

MONDAY

This is our day off, we have pancakes for breakfast and often go out of town for at least part of the day.

Please pray for a good day off each week and good family time together.

TUESDAY

AM Sarah, Grace, Isaac and Caleb start the week's homeschool working from 8:30am to early afternoon. Caleb works one on one with Sarah while Grace and Isaac work mostly independent. We homeschool from Tuesday to Friday.

Mark is in the office beginning preparation for his duties that week including preaching, leading the service, leading prayer meeting and leading English Fun Club.

FRIDAY

AM Mark teaches maths to Isaac and reviews Grace's homeschool progress. Sarah and Grace teach English at a local kindergarten every other week involving balloons and lots of running around.


