THE PARISH OF ST PETER & ST PAUL, TONBRIDGE Key points for those attending services during the COVID-19 crisis (as at 31/03/21)

- SOCIAL DISTANCING of 2 metres MUST be maintained at all times outside & inside of the church, especially if queuing occurs. <u>Do not stop to mingle</u> <u>immediately outside of, or on paths near to, the church entrance either</u> <u>before or after services!</u> Please make use of open space in the churchyard & remember the rule of 6 when catching up with others.
- **WEARING OF FACE COVERINGS** is required at all times unless exempt.
- Once in the foyer, CLEAN HANDS WITH SANITISER supplied.
- Toilets are available with extra cleaning sprays and hand washing facilities.
- Children are welcome and should stay within their "bubble".
- Arrive in good time to be seated.
- For NHS Test and Trace <u>either</u> register the QR code on your phone <u>or</u> sign in using the consent form in the foyer for yourself and others in your "bubble".
- If using a pen supplied by the church, it should be placed in the box marked for used pens and <u>not</u> mixed with other pens.
- Take seats as directed by stewards and stay in those seats.
- Wait at end of the service to be directed to leave by stewards and proceed to vacate the church promptly.
- Clean hands with sanitiser on leaving the church.
- A collection plate & card reader will be available at the end of the service for those wishing to donate.
