- **Encouraging Safeguarding Awareness!** Safeguarding is at the heart of the Gospel, aiming to protect people, especially the most vulnerable. There are various awareness and training courses available free of charge from the Church of England, and if you have not completed these, can we encourage you to consider completing the first two levels. We are asking you to do this training to support our commitment to safeguarding in this parish; and in our commitment to you, please do contact us if we can support you in any way to do this training, whether that is practically, prayerfully or with follow up support.
