We know lots of this goes on already in our church, but as part of our pastoral care for one another, we are launching a new initiative called 'Take them a meal', where anyone who would like to bless someone with a meal (homecooked or shop bought), can sign up to be on our 'providers' list. As and when we know of someone who would be blessed by receiving a meal for a duration, we would then call upon that list to provide meals for one another!
