

## February 2026 Prayer Guide

### Monday prayer points: Preaching

- This month is the third and final month of Langham Preaching Director Paul Windsor's much-needed sabbatical. Please pray that he will continue being refreshed as he rests from his usual duties. Pray that the Lord will help and strengthen Paul when he returns in March.
- Pray for Andy Oatridge, Director for Langham Preaching in Europe and the Caribbean, who has been in the role a few months. Pray that the Lord will give Andy much encouragement.
- Last month, a Level 1 seminar took place for Arabic-speaking people in a sensitive Middle Eastern country for the first time. Please pray that this will be the beginning of a training hub serving Arabic-speaking people across this region.
- Give thanks for Langham Preaching's coordinator for Indonesia Hamdani Tedja, who has served faithfully in this role for a number of years. Praise God that his team has translated 17 books into Indonesian to equip pastors in remote areas. Pray they'll be used by many Indonesian pastors.

### Tuesday prayer points: Literature

- Give thanks to God for the dedicated Literature Distribution staff who work out of the Langham Service Centre in Carlisle. Continue to pray for Roshi Philip and his team, especially as the 'Library Grants' season gets underway this month (*through this scheme, nearly 700 Majority World Bible Colleges order contextually relevant resources either for free or at heavily discounted rates*).
- Pray for the evangelical publishers around the world, which are supported by Langham. Pray that they may be encouraged to persevere in what can be a difficult and wearying job. Pray for energy and creativity in making Biblical truths public through writing and publishing.
- The Latin American Bible Commentary was published in 2018 and has been distributed and used by thousands of believers across the region. Please pray that this important commentary will continue to be read and utilised by preachers across Latin America.
- Pray that the Lord would bless the work of Sophia Soloviy, Langham Publishing's Communications and PR Coordinator, as she spreads the word about Langham's amazing books!

### Wednesday prayer points: Scholars

- Pray for Gaynor Harvey in her vital role as the Registrar for the Langham Scholars programme (based in Scotland). Pray for much grace as she administers hundreds of applications.
- Pray for Parush Parushev, Associate Director for Academic Development, who lives in Bulgaria. Pray that God will give Parush strength and energy in all his duties.
- Pray for Teresa David, the first woman from Angola to obtain a PhD in biblical studies, who is seeking to help the Church fight cultures of corruption both inside and outside.

- Praise God for Langham Graduate Samuel Sarkodie-Addo, who lives in Ghana, and is involved in many ministries: preaching, lecturing, researching and more. Pray particularly for his work with 'Transformative Stewardship Africa', seeking to bring biblical stewardship principles to Ghana.

- Please pray that more funds would be raised from supporters in the UK and Ireland, so that Langham's work "on the ground" can go forward and increase. *Bless the work of our hands Lord.*
