Monday prayer points: Scholars

- Give thanks for Elizabeth Hitchcock, Executive Assistant for the Scholars programme, who lives in the UK. Pray that the Lord would give her energy in this vital role!
- Pray for Langham Scholar Alejandra Ortiz, who lives with her family in Mexico, while studying for a PhD via the Oxford Centre for Mission Studies. She is researching the impact of women on student ministry in Latin America; pray her studies would greatly impact the wider Church there.
- Pray for Danny Crowther, in his dual role as a Scholar Care Coordinator, and Assistant Director for Academic Development. Pray for perseverance and insight as he supports many scholars.
- Praise God for Langham Graduate Emmanuel Ndikumana, from Burundi, who graduated with a PhD from the Oxford Centre for Mission Studies in 2024. Pray that he will continue to equip Bible teachers and serve the Church through ministries he has pioneered.

Tuesday prayer points: Preaching

- Pray for Emeka Egbo, who is taking on the role of Preaching Director for Africa from Femi Adeleye, after a number of fruitful years. Pray for stamina and guidance for Emeka as he leads this important work. Pray also for Femi as he continues to serve the Lord in Africa.

- Give thanks for the recent release of *'Unlocking the Old Testament'* by Langham Graduate Dr Yohanna Katanacho, who is an Old Testament Professor and Academic Dean at Nazareth Evangelical College. Please pray that this book will particularly help Arab Christians to see Christ in the Old Testament, during these troubled times.
- Please pray for the upcoming release of the 'South Asia Study Bible', a one-volume resource written by South Asian Christians for the Church in South Asia (and beyond!). Pray there won't be

any delays and for the last stages of this long-awaited project to go smoothly.

Friday prayer points: The Middle East

As we watch the current crisis unfold in Iran and the Middle East, please join us in prayer for the Langham-connected church leaders in the region.

- Pray for Langham Graduate Hikmat Kashouh, who pastors a church in Beirut, Lebanon. They shelter hundreds of displaced people through their humanitarian outreach programmes. The church has shared: "Even in the middle of fear, God is still drawing people close and caring for them through His family."
- Pray for Langham Graduate Walid Zailaa, the Academic Dean of a seminary in Lebanon, which is serving refugees. Pray that the Holy Spirit would guard this ministry.
- Pray for Rula Mansour, who leads a peace-building ministry in Nazareth. Pray that God would help her at this time.
- Please pray earnestly for peace in the Middle East; for comfort for God's people; for the light of Jesus Christ to shine brightly at this time.
