Monday prayer points: Literature

- This year's 'Library Grant' season will conclude this month. Give thanks for the many books that have been sent to colleges throughout the Majority World. Pray that they will be a source of inspiration and a deepening knowledge for all who use them.
- Pray for Roman Soloviy, Langham's Regional Commissioning Editor for Central/Eastern Europe & Central Asia, who is based in Ukraine. Pray especially for a just end to the war in Ukraine, for comfort and courage for God's people there, and for Roman in his role for Langham.
- Give thanks for Claire Moore, based at the Langham Service Centre in Carlisle – she is Langham's Editorial Coordinator and looks after French titles. Pray for wisdom and focus.

Tuesday prayer points: Scholars
